1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was credited with 21 days of leave erroneously charged.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 15 March 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In accordance with reference (b), any delay authorized in orders directing a permanent change of station (PCS) in excess of allowed proceed time or travel time is chargeable to leave.

c. On 7 October 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2810) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of February 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 15 March 2021 and departure date of 26 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 29 March 2021 and departure date of 9 April 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 12 April

2021 and departure date of 16 April 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of April 2021.

d. On 15 February 2021, Petitioner received a departure endorsement from [REDACTED] which is also reflected in Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS).

e. On 15 February 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] in accordance with NSIPS.

f. On 23 February 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2810) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of February 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 15 March 2021 and departure date of 28 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 29 March 2021 and departure date of 9 April 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 12 April 2021 and departure date of 16 April 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of April 2021.

g. On 1 March 2021, Petitioner received an arrival endorsement from [REDACTED] which is also reflected in NSIPS.

h. On 9 March 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2810) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of February 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 1 March 2021 and departure date of 12 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 15 March 2021 and departure date of 28 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 29 March 2021 and departure date of 9 April 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 12 April 2021 and departure date of 16 April 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of April 2021.

i. On 13 March 2021, Petitioner received a departure endorsement from [REDACTED] and received an arrival endorsement from [REDACTED].

j. On 15 March 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED] in accordance with NSIPS.

k. On 5 April 2021, Petitioner arrived to [REDACTED] for duty in accordance with NSIPS.

l. On 16 April 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2810) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective

date of departure of February 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 1 March 2021 and departure date of 15 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 15 March 2021 and departure date of 28 March 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 29 March 2021 and departure date of 9 April 2021. Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 12 April 2021 and departure date of 16 April 2021. m. On 16 April 2021, Petitioner received a departure endorsement from [REDACTED].

n. On 17 April 2021, Petitioner received an arrival endorsement from [REDACTED]

o. On 4 May 2021, Petitioner signed a Temporary Lodging Expense (TLE) Allowance Certification (NPPSC 7220/2) for the period of 16 April 2021 to 17 April 2021 while at Navy Lodge, [REDACTED]

p. On 4 May 2021, Petitioner signed and submitted a Travel Voucher or Sub-voucher (DD Form 1351-2).

q. On 19 November 2021, Petitioner was charged leave from 15 March 2021 to 4 April 2021 (21 days).

r. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that in accordance with official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2810) of 16 April 2021, Petitioner's intermediate activity was [REDACTED] with an effective date of arrival of 15 March 2021 to 28 March 2021 with follow on schools of 29 March 2021 to 9 April 2021, and 12 April 2021 to 16 April 2021. Due to the discrepancy between the endorsements of her orders and the dates listed in NSIPS, the Board determined that Petitioner was erroneously charged leave while at [REDACTED]. Petitioner requested restoration of 21 days of leave; however, the Board determined that an audit of Petitioner's travel claim should be conducted to determine the number of days leave Petitioner is owed for the period of 13 March 2021 and 16 April 2021.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner arrived to [REDACTED] on 13 March 2021, and departed on 16 April 2021.

Note: As a result of this change, Petitioner is required to resubmit travel claim. Petitioner was charged leave from 15 March 2021 to 4 April 2021 while on temporary duty and temporary duty under instruction.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

That part of the Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing be denied.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
