

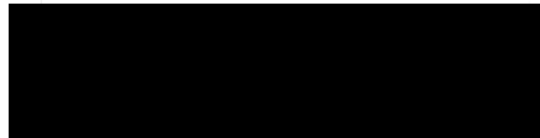


making this finding, the Board relied on your entrance physical that documented you used an inhaler prior to entering the Marine Corps. In light of these findings, the Board did not find any error or injustice in your entry-level separation. Accordingly, the Board found insufficient evidence of error or injustice to warrant relief.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
