1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his record be corrected by removing from his official military personnel file (OMPF) enclosure (2), the evaluation covering the period 1 October 2020 to 15 November 2021.

2. The Board, consisting of █, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 July 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Petitioner received two evaluation reports, one from █, enclosure (2), and one from NAVTALACQGRU █ that cover the same period ending 15 November 2021. Petitioner contends enclosure (2) is erroneous and needs to be removed. Petitioner included enclosure (3), a history of assignments with his request, which shows Petitioner was assigned to NAVTALACQGRU █ during the reporting period and was never assigned to █

c. Enclosure (4), an advisory opinion (AO) furnished by Navy Personnel Command (PERS-32) recommended granting Petitioner's request. PERS-32 noted that Petitioner's prior assignment was to Navy Operational Support Center (NOSC) █ and that a detachment

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evaluation report showed that Petitioner detached on 30 September 2020 and transferred to NAVTALACQGRU [REDACTED] PERS-32 found that enclosure (2) is erroneous and should be removed.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the advisory opinion, the Board determined that Petitioner's request warrants relief. Petitioner was never assigned to [REDACTED] and the command submitted an erroneous evaluation for the Petitioner. The Board thus concluded that enclosure (2), the evaluation report of 1 October 2020 to 15 November 2021 issued by [REDACTED] shall be removed.

#### RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above, the Board recommends the following corrective action:

Remove enclosure (2), the evaluation report issued by [REDACTED] covering the period 1 October 2020 to 15 November 2021, from Petitioner's record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
