1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).	
allegat that the Docun	Board, consisting of provided perition, and previewed Petitioner's ions of error and injustice on 12 April 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined a corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. The nentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of the ner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
	Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of nd injustice, finds as follows:
	Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
	On 19 January 2016, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active ted Service (EAOS) of 18 January 2020.
c. (On 19 October 2018, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 18 October 2022.

e. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component (AC) and Full-Time Support (FTS), superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must have reenlisted within 365-days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270-days required in

reference (a), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

Commands were required to submit SRB reenlistment requests to the Enlisted Community Support Branch (BUPERS-328) via Officer Personnel Information System (OPINS) or Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) 35 to 120 days in advance of the requested reenlistment date of the Sailor. Requests submitted less than 35 days prior to the requested reenlistment date were rejected. However, commands may contact BUPERS-328 for waiver eligibility evaluation and procedural assistance. Sailors must have had an approved SRB request before reenlisting.

- f. On 26 April 2021, Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that she was authorized immediate in-rate reenlistment in the Active Component (AC) component with an end date of August 2022.
- g. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21) listed a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the AM rate.
- h. On 21 October 2021, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 6 year reenlistment with an effective date of 18 January 2022. The request was approved by cognizant authority on 3 November 2021.
 - i. On 18 January 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 17 January 2028.
- j. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was eligible for a Zone A SRB for her 6 year term reenlistment of 18 January 2022. If the Command Career Counselor had submitted the SRB precertification to BUPERS-328 via Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) 35 to 120 days in advance of member's requested reenlistment date, the member would have been approved.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's command submitted an OPINS/ NSIPS request 35 to 120 days in advance of the requested reenlistment date for the Sailor, and was it approved by cognizant authority.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 dollar award ceiling) for the MA rate. Remaining obligated service to 18 October 2022 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
