1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's advancement from the September 2020 (Cycle 248) Navy-Wide Advancement Examination (NWAE) due to missing education points.

2. The Board, consisting of █, █, and █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 June 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 21 October 2016 Petitioner enlist in Navy Reserve Delayed Entry Program (DEP) for 8 years in the pay grade of E-3 of which 4 years is active duty obligation. Petitioner's DD Form 1966 reflects "16K" in block 12 (Education) with block 22 reflecting "graduate of Benedictine College."

b. On 11 September 2020 Petitioner's Advancement Worksheet for the September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE reflects "No Degree."

c. Petitioner's Examination Profile for exam rate HM3 for the September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE reflects "0.00" education points, Final Multiple Score (FMS) 118.04, Minimum Multiple Required (MMR) 119.27, Status: PNA-PTS 0.0/1.5.

d. On 12 January 2021 and 9 March 2021 the Commanding Officer, █, █ submits Petitioner Cycle 248 correction request to CO, █. Petitioner's Joint Services Transcript printed on 9 March 2021 reflect BA degree in Biology completed on 17 May 2014. Petitioner's ESR NSIPS education record on the Member Data Summary of 24 May 2022 reflect Baccalaureate Degree, 16 education years.

e. On 26 May 2022 [REDACTED] representative provides BCNR examiner with recalculation of Cycle 248 with appropriate "4" education points.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner acquired education points prior to the September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE that were not calculated in his Final Multiple Score, warranting relief.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE for rate HM3 reflects "4.00" Education Points vice "0.00"; FMS "122.04" vice "118.04"; Status: "Selectee" vice "PNA-PTS 0.0/1.5"

Petitioner advanced to HM3 E-4 effective 16 April 2021 with a time in rate date of 1 January 2021.

Note: The change to the effective date for advancement to E4 may also impact on Petitioner's E5 advancement opportunity. If Petitioner was eligible for, but did not take the E5 examination because the above change had not yet been made, the following procedures will apply to remediate that missed opportunity. Petitioner should reapply to this Board for consideration of advancement to E6 retroactive to the date Petitioner would have been advanced on the "missed" examination cycle(s). Petitioner should then submit a copy of worksheet for the cycle(s).

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
