Dear █:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board for Correction of Naval Records, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 16 June 2022. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

Regarding your request for a personal appearance, the Board determined that a personal appearance with or without counsel will not materially add to their understanding of the issue(s) involved. Therefore, the Board determined that a personal appearance was not necessary and considered your case based on the evidence of record.

On 25 May 2007, you signed an Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office (NAVPERS 1000/4) in the active U.S. Navy as an █ with a day of rank of 25 May 2007 with a designator code of █

On 29 January 2014, you were issued official separation orders (BUPERS order: 0294) while stationed in █ with an effective date of departure of February 2014. Present Commanding Officer directed to detach you in time to permit completion separation processing not later than 28 February 2014. The Secretary of the Navy accepted your resignation of your present commission in the U.S. Naval service submitted on 15 November 2013, effective upon required acceptance of appointment in U.S. Naval Reserve on the date of detachment from activity at which separated.
