

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) reflect Petitioner's current legal name.
- 2. The Board consisting of all property, and previewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 13 May 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies, to include the 25 July 2018 guidance from the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness regarding equity, injustice or clemency determinations (Wilkie Memo).
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record, along with the previously issued DD Form 214 and DD Form 215 which reflects the name and the updated DD Form 214 which reflects the name
Petitioner be issued a new DD Form 214 and a new discharge certificate which reflects the name
That no further changes be made to the record.
