Dear ██████████:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 7 July 2022. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion by Community Management Support Branch memorandum of 24 May 2022 and your response to the opinion.

In accordance with MILPERSMAN 1306-124, split tours are defined as permanent change of station (PCS) assignment between two activities in the same geographic location. Same geographic location is defined as any PCS move for which the total expected cost, including member's travel and transportation entitlements, does not exceed \$1,000.00. Any PCS move that exceeds the \$1,000.00 becomes a cost move and is considered as an assignment outside of the geographic location.

On 1 March 2019, you reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service of 28 February 2023.

On 17 May 2021, you were issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) with required obligated service to July 2023, while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of June 2021. Your ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 July 2021.

In May 2021, an agreement to extend enlistment for 5 months was executed with an Soft End of Active Obligated Service of 31 July 2023. On 14 June 2021, you transferred from ██████████ BLUE. On 10 August 2021, you arrived to ██████████ for duty.

You requested to cancel your 5-month extension that has not become operative; the Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertion that you split toured from USS ██████████ and when that happens your projected rotation date (PRD) stays the same. However, the Board concluded that in accordance with MILPERSMAN 1306-124, your assignment to SSN ██████████ does not qualify as a Split Tour because ██████████ is not in the same geographical region as ██████████. Furthermore, BUPERS Order ██████████ required you to obligate service out to July 2023 and listed your PRD as July 2023. You executed an extension to fulfill the OBLISERV requirement and subsequently reported to SSN ██████████ on 10 August 2021, therefore, you are not authorized to cancel the extension. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the advisory opinion.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
