This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 22 September 2022. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board also considered the advisory opinion by Navy Personnel command memorandum 1900 PERS-312/DV of 22 June 2022, which was previously provided to you. You were afforded an opportunity to submit a rebuttal, but did not do so.

On 6 February 2007, you enlisted in the Naval Reserve for 8 years with an expiration of obligated service of 5 February 2015. On 27 February 2007, you entered active duty for 4 years with an end of active obligated service of 26 February 2011 and soft end of active obligated service of 26 February 2012. You were released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve with an Honorable character of service and were issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 5 February 2007 to 26 December 2010 upon completion of required active service. On 5 February 2015, you were honorably discharged from the Naval Reserve.

You requested your DD Form 214 executed on 26 December 2010 block 12a (Date Entered Active Duty This Period) reflect 6 February 2007 vice 5 February 2007; the Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. However, the Board concluded that your enlistment/reenlistment Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4) block 5 (Date of Enlistment/Reenlistment) reflects 6 February 2007, which is the date you entered the Delayed
