Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's effective date of BUPERS Order (Official Retirement Orders) to a date acceptable for Personally Procured Move (PPM) of Household Goods (HHG) shipment claim processing and payment per reference (b). 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's , and allegations of error and injustice on 26 May 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. On 20 September 2021 Petitioner executes shipment of HHG PPM effective this date per NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Norfolk letter of 22 February 2022.
- b. On 15 November 2021 Petitioner issued BUPERS Order (Official Retirement Orders) with estimated date of departure during May 2022 with transfer to the Retired List effective 1 June 2022.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded per reference (b) HHG allowances are based on the when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute HHG transportation before an order is issued. The Petitioner failed to meet the requirements and began execution of HHG shipment prior to issuance of orders. To eliminate financial burden for the Petitioner relief is granted.

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's BUPERS Order (Official Retirement Orders) issued 19 September 2021 vice 15 November 2021. Petitioner authorized to submit HHG claim utilizing funding from BUPERS Order.
