Dear ██████████:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

Although your application was not filed in a timely manner, the Board found it in the interest of justice to waive the statute of limitations and consider your case on its merits. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 9 June 2022. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. Therefore, the Board determined that a personal appearance was not necessary and considered your case based on the evidence of record.

On 29 January 1965, you entered active duty. On 14 April 1965, you were advanced to FA/E-2. On 9 December 1965, your rate was changed from FA/E-2 to SA/E-2. On 16 July 1966, you were advanced to BMSN/E-3. On 9 June 1967, you were recommended for BM3. On 16 September 1967, your report of enlistment performance evaluation for the period of 17 March 1967 to 16 September 1967 stated that you were recommended for E-4. On 18 December 1967, Commanding Officer, ██████████ notified you of termination of active service in the Regular Navy and transfer to the U.S. Naval reserve, inactive duty, as an SN/E-3. On 18 December 1967, you were honorably released from active duty and transferred to the Naval Reserve. Furthermore, it listed that you had completed military requirements for Petty Officers 3&2. On 28 January 1971, you were honorably discharged from the Naval Reserve as a SN/E-3.
