1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) effective 30 September 2011 to reflect Date Entered AD the Period (Item 12a) to reflect "1983 04 03" vice "1989 06 27" capturing period of active duty of 3 April 1983 through 26 June 1989 currently unaccounted for via issuance of DD Form 214.

2. The Board, consisting of █, █, and █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 June 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 31 March 1983 Petitioner appointed █; Type of duty active, type of appointment permanent, USNR, and enter active duty status effective 3 April 1983 per Statement of Service(s) created in April 1983, 12 December 2001, and 8 October 2010. All of which reside in the Petitioner Official Military Personnel File.

b. On 27 June 1989 Petitioner accepted appointment in the Regular Navy in the permanent grade of █ with a date of rank of 1 August 1985. The Petitioner was not issued a DD Form 214 for the period of active duty of 3 April 1983 through 26 June 1989 as required by reference (b). The above mentioned 2001 and 2010 Statement of Service(s) reflect the Petitioner was on active duty during this period.

c. On 30 September 2011 Petitioner transferred to the Retired List and was issued a DD Form 214 with Item 12a (Date Entered AD this Period) of 27 June 1989.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that partial relief could be granted due to the requirement of issuance of a complete DD Form 214 effective 26 June 1989, per reference (b)<sup>1</sup>.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner be issued Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the active duty period of 3 April 1983 through 26 June 1989 ensuring all required service data history entered and appropriately distributed to all agencies as required.

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's naval record.

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.

The DD 214 will be prepared and furnished to members while serving on active duty when they have a change of status or component as follows: (b) Officers:  
1. Reserve appointment terminated to accept appointment in the Regular Navy. 2. Temporary appointment terminated to accept a permanent warrant or commission in the Regular Navy or Naval Reserve.
