1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show petitioner was eligible for and received an Aircraft Maintenance Kicker.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 June 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies, to include reference (b).

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 9 October 2007, Petitioner entered active duty.

c. On 1 February 2015, Petitioner was promoted to Staff Sergeant/E-6.

d. On 27 September 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years and 6 months with an End of Current Contract (ECC) of 26 March 2022.

e. On 11 June 2018, Petitioner was joined to ██████████) for duty.

f. On 30 November 2020, Petitioner's QAR/CDQAR/CDI Qualification Summary shows Petitioner's Quality Assurance Representative Designation is being active effective 15 July 2020.

g. On 13 May 2021, Petitioner submitted a Reenlistment Extension Lateral Move (RELM) Request (NAVMC 11537) in order to reenlist for 4 years in Primary Military Occupational Specialties of 6217. Petitioner's request was approved by cognizant authority on 29 May 2021.

- h. On 17 September 2021, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Lateral Move request was submitted.
- i. On 9 October 2021, Petitioner entered zone "D."
- j. On 18 January 2022, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Lateral Move was approved by HQMC.
- k. On 20 January 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an ECC of 19 January 2026.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2)<sup>1</sup>, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that when Petitioner submitted his RELM Request (NAVMC 11537), he was still in zone "C," however, due to processing time and no fault of Petitioner, he crossed into Zone "D" and was ineligible to receive the Aircraft Maintenance Kicker.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 7/8 October 2021, vice on 19/20 January 2022 for a term of 4 years and 6 months vice 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a \$20,000 Aircraft Maintenance Kicker.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
