1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Retention Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 June 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies, to include references (b) through (d).

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 2 December 2019, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an EAOS of 1 December 2023.

b. On 2 November 2021, Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that he was authorized immediate in-rate reenlistment in the Active Component with an end date of March 2023.

c. On 8 December 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) with a required obligated service to June 2025, while stationed in ██████████, with an effective date of departure of May 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 June 2022.

d. On 29 March 2022, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 4 year reenlistment with an effective date of 13 April 2022. The request was approved by cognizant authority on 11 April 2022.

e. On 13 April 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 12 April 2026.

f. On 5 May 2022, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 26 May 2022 for duty.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2)<sup>1</sup>, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was required to obligate service out to June 2025 in accordance with BUPERS Order [REDACTED] N13SRB 001/FY22 was published on 14 February 2022, reducing the SRB award level from 0.5 to 0.0 for the MA rate, effective on 16 March 2022. If the Command Career Counselor had submitted a request to change the Petitioner's reenlistment date he would have been approved to receive the 0.5 award level SRB.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 14/15 March 2022, vice on 12/13 April 2022 for a term of 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the MA rate. Remaining obligated service to 1 December 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
