- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner was entitled to a received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of and and reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 July 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
 - b. On 7 May 2008, Petitioner entered active duty.
- c. On 1 November 2015, Petitioner reenlisted for 5 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 31 October 2021 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service of 28 February 2022.
- d. In accordance with reference (b), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21) was published listing a zone "C" SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the ITS rate.
- e. On 6 December 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3401) with a required obligated service to February 2025 while stationed in the stationed in the stationed of departure of March 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 31 March 2022.
- f. On 9 December 2021, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 6 year reenlistment with an effective date of 28 February 2022. The request was approved by cognizant authority on 14 December 2021.

- g. In accordance with reference (c), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 001/FY22) was published listing a zone "C" SRB with an award level of 0.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the ITS rate.
 - h. On 28 February 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 27 February 2028.
- i. On 2 March 2022, Petitioner transferred from and arrived to on 31 March 2022 for duty.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2)¹, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner reenlisted on 28 February 2022 for 6 years and was eligible for the Zone C, ITS, 1.0 award level SRB. The SRB precertification was entered into Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) incorrectly resulting in the SRB precertification to be rejected. If the SRB request had been properly submitted, he would have been approved for Zone C, ITS, 1.0 award level SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's command submitted an Officer Personnel Information System/NSIPS request 35 to 120 days in advance of the requested reenlistment date for the Sailor, and was it approved by cognizant authority.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "C" SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the ITS rate. Remaining obligated service to 28 February 2022 will be deducted from SRB computation

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
