1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting her naval record be corrected by removing the Fitness Report & Counseling Record (fitness report) at enclosure (2).

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulation within the Department of the Navy.

b. Petitioner was issued enclosure (2), a detachment of individual, regular fitness report for the reporting period 1 February 2022 to 31 May 2022. However, she was subsequently extended onboard the command an additional six months.

c. The Advisory Opinion (AO) at enclosure (3) noted Petitioner did not detach from the command and a review of Petitioner's history of assignments indicates she remains onboard the command. The AO states no objection to removing enclosure (2) upon receipt of the next scheduled fitness report, supplemental material from the Reporting Senior requesting removal, or a directive from the Board to do so.

d. After enclosure (3) was provided to Petitioner, enclosure (4), a detachment of Reporting Senior fitness report for the reporting period 1 February 2022 to 24 June 2022, was issued and inserted in Petitioner's record.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an error and injustice warranting relief. The Board concurred with the AO and concluded the submission of enclosure (4) for the reporting period 1 February 2022 to 24 June 2022 supports the removal of enclosure (2).

RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above, the Board recommends the following corrective action.

Petitioner's naval record be corrected by removing the detachment of individual fitness report at enclosure (2) for the reporting period 1 February 2022 to 31 May 2022.

Petitioner's Performance Summary Report be corrected to appropriately reflect the directed action.

Any material or entries inconsistent with or relating to the Board's recommendation be corrected, removed or completely expunged from Petitioner's record and that no such entries or material be added to the record in the future.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
