1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to reflect Home of Record (HOR) as ██████████, ██████████.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 18 October 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies, to include reference (b).<sup>1</sup>

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, she exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 25 August 2016 Petitioner enlisted in the Navy for a term of 8 years under the Surface Warfare Officer (SWO) program; Block 3 (Home of Record (HOR)) indicates ██████████, ██████████, ██████████.

b. Petitioner served on active duty from 10 September 2016 through 9 November 2016 and was discharged for "Failure to Complete Commissioning or Warrant Program."

c. On 21 February 2022 Petitioner signed NAVPERS 1000/4, Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office, and entered service. Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System reflects Petitioner's HOR as ██████████.

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<sup>1</sup> Reference (b), the HOR and or PLEAD are used to determine a member's entitlement to travel and transportation allowances or other compensations provided by law. To support these entitlements, these places will be documented and must not be changed, except as authorized. HOR is the place recorded as the Service member's home when commissioned, appointed, enlisted, inducted, or ordered into a tour of active duty.

d. On 14 June 2022 Petitioner and Certifying Officer signed NAVPERS 1070/74, Report of Home of Record and Place from Which Ordered to Active Duty; Block 1 (Home of Record) indicates [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

e. Petitioner provided the Board with evidence of HOR in [REDACTED] prior to commissioning on 21 February 2022 to include: Letter from Title Company; [REDACTED] Driver Licenses; and [REDACTED] Voter Registration Card. On 11 October 2022, Petitioner certified, "I have never been to [REDACTED]."

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2),<sup>2</sup> the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect HOR in [REDACTED], [REDACTED] prior to commissioning on 21 February 2022. Additionally, there is no documentation in Petitioner's record to support Indiana as her HOR. Therefore, the Board felt, under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

On 21 February 2022, Petitioner and Certifying Officer signed NAVPERS 1070/74, Report of Home of Record and Place from Which Ordered to Active Duty listing HOR and place from which called or ordered to active duty (PLEAD) as [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

Note: Additional changes to Petitioner's official military personnel file may be required based on this change.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
