1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect Home of Record (HOR) as ██████████, ███ vice ██████████, ███.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 11 August 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 24 August 1987, Petitioner enlisted in the Naval Reserve for a period of 8 years of which 4-years was an active duty obligation. HOR listed as ██████████, ██████████, ██████████ with an Active Duty Service Date (ADSD) of 12 July 1988.

b. On 12 July 1998, Petitioner accessed onto active duty from ██████████, ███ and signed DD Form 1966/5, Record of Military Processing with change to Block 5 (Home of Record Address) reflecting ██████████, ██████████, ██████████.

c. Petitioner reenlisted on 7 October 1991 for a term of 6-years.

d. Petitioner discharged on 29 December 1995; DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, reflects Block 7.a. (Place of Entry into Active Duty) ██████████, ███; and Block 7.b. (Home of Record at Time of Entry) ██████████, ███.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2),¹ the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner's HOR at the time of enlistment was annotated as [REDACTED], [REDACTED], however, upon recertifying at the time of accession, Petitioner's HOR was changed to [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. Because the record reflects Petitioner attempted to make corrections to his HOR at the time of accession and entry from [REDACTED], [REDACTED], the Board felt, under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's enlistment documents (DD Form 4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Document and DD Form 1966, Record of Military Processing) dated 24 August 1987 are amended to reflect HOR as

"[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED]."

Petitioner issued DD Form 215, Correction to DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty dated 29 December 1995 modifying Block 7.a. (Place of Entry into Active Duty)

"[REDACTED], [REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED], [REDACTED]"; and Block 7.b. (Home of Record at Time of Entry)

"[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED], [REDACTED]."

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
