The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings: |  |
| a. On 24 August 1987, Petitioner enlisted in the Naval Reserve for a period of 8 years of which 4-years was an active duty obligation. HOR listed as with an Active Duty Service Date (ADSD) of 12 July 1988.   |  |
| b. On 12 July 1998, Petitioner accessed onto active duty from, and signed DD Form 1966/5, Record of Military Processing with change to Block 5 (Home of Record Address) reflecting,   |  |
