1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that he be authorized to wear the Naval Aviation Observer (NAO) wings and that it be reflected on his Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214).

2. The Board, consisting of **Constants**, **Constants**, and **Constants**, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 3 May 2023, and, pursuant to its regulations, determined the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of his naval service records, applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Although enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to review the application on its merits.

c. Petitioner was commissioned as an officer in the U.S. Navy Reserve and commenced active duty on 19 July 1969. His record reflects that he commenced a present continuous tour with the Fleet Air Reconnaissance Squadron from 30 December 1970 until 15 April 1971. Petitioner was discharged on 23 July 1972, with an Honorable discharge after the expiration of active obligated service.

e. In light of the Petitioner's request that he be awarded the NAO wings, the Board requested enclosure (3). The AO stated in pertinent part:

After a thorough review of the case documents submitted by the Petitioner it has been determined that ______ met the requirements to be designated a Naval Aviation Observer in accordance with reference (b).

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants relief.

The Board determined it was in the interests of justice to properly document the awards earned while he was on active duty service. Therefore, the Board concluded the Navy shall issue a Correction to Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 215) reflecting the authorization of NAO wings.

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action:

That Petitioner be issued a Correction to DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 215) reflecting his entitlement to NAO wings.

No further changes be made to Petitioner's record.

A copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulation, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
