1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect date entered active duty service as 8 April 1965 on DD Form 214N, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge ending on 7 April 1967.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 10 January 2023 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 8 April 1965 Petitioner entered active duty, and was released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve on 7 April 1967. Petitioner discharged from the Navy Reserve on 19 January 1970.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner was issued DD Form 214N for active duty service period of 8 April 1965 through 7 April 1967. However, the year of separation was accidentally used as the year of entry [8 April "1967"], therefore, the Board agreed, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214N, Armed Forces of the United States Report of Transfer or Discharge (DD Form 214N) ending on 7 April 1967 is amended to reflect Block 17c (Date of Entry) "8 April 1965" vice "8 April 1967".

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
