1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish eligibility for Enlisted Bonus for Source Rate (EBSR).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 6 December 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 26 October 2017, Petitioner enlisted in the Naval Reserve for a term of 8 years of which 4 years was considered an active duty obligation. NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees - Annex "A" listed Aviation Electronic, Electrical, & Computer Systems Technician (AV/SG) Program Guarantee. Active Duty Service Date (ADSD): 6 June 2018.

b. On 14 November 2017, Petitioner signed NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees - Annex "B" which listed Advanced Technical Field Special Warfare Operator (ATF/SO 6YO) Challenge Program; and EBSR - \$12,000 Bonus. ADSD: 8 February 2018.

c. On 14 June 2018, Petitioner signed NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees - Annex "C" which listed ATF Navy Diver (ATF/ND 6YO) Challenge Program. ADSD: 11 December 2017.

d. Petitioner's ADSD is 11 December 2017.

e. On 28 June 2018, Petitioner issued Secret clearance.

f. On 10 February 2018, Petitioner completed Recruit Basic Military Training.

g. On 31 July 2018, Petitioner completed ND Basic Engineering Course.

h. On 20 February 2019, Petitioner completed Diver Second Class course and awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) M2DV effective 1 February 2019.

i. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. In accordance with reference (b), Petitioner met the criteria to receive \$15,000 EBSR after reclassification to ATF/ND. However, NAVPERS 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantees – Annex "C" was inadvertently issued without \$15,000 EBSR. Although the proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board felt that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's NAVCRUIT 1133/52, Enlistment Guarantee - Annex "C" to DD Form 4 dated 26 October 2017 is modified to reflect Option 2: "Enlistment Bonus for Source Rating (EBSR) - \$15,000 Bonus" vice "N/A."

This change will entitle Petitioner to receive \$15,000 EBSR upon completion of Diver Second Class course and earning the rating NEC on 20 February 2019.

Note: Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine retroactive enlistment bonus entitlement.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the
