1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted for a term of 6 years on 21 July 2022, and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 November 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 13 August 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 12 August 2022 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) of 12 August 2023.

c. On 10 February 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) while stationed in ██████████, ██████████ with an effective date of departure of March 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████, ██████████ for

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duty with an effective date of arrival of 20 April 2020, with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of October 2024.

d. On 26 March 2020, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 27 March 2020 for duty.

e. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component (AC) and Full-Time Support (FTS), superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365-days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270-days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

f. On 1 May 2022, Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that he was authorized immediate in-rate reenlistment in the active component with an end date of August 2023.

g. In accordance with reference (c), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 002/FY22) a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.5 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the FT rate was listed.

h. On 7 June 2022, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 6 year reenlistment effective 21 July 2022. Petitioner's request was approved on 10 June 2022 by cognizant authority.

i. In accordance with reference (d), FY22 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 003/FY22) no zone "A" SRB for the FT rate was listed.

j. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of references (b), (c), and (d), and enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner's EAOS was within 365 days of his requested reenlistment date of 21 July 2022 and Petitioner's command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requested a 6-year reenlistment effective 21 July 2022 which was approved on 10 June 2022 by his command. If the Command Career Counselor (CCC) had submitted the SRB precertification request prior to 28 June 2022, the date of the reduction as listed in reference (d), it would have been approved.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged on 20 July 2022 and reenlisted on 21 July 2022 for a term of 6 years.

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Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.5 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the FT rate. Remaining obligated service to 12 August 2022 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
