1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's date of birth on the Report of Separation from Active Duty (DD Form 214N) ending 11 November 1977 corrected to show [REDACTED] vice [REDACTED].

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 25 January 2023 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 12 November 1974 Petitioner enlisted for 3 years with an end of active obligated service of 11 November 1977. Furthermore, Petitioner's date of birth was listed as [REDACTED].

b. Petitioner was released from active duty and transferred to Naval Reserve with an honorable character of service and was issued a Form 214N for the period of 12 November 1974 to 11 November 1977 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, Petitioner's date of birth was listed as [REDACTED].

c. On 11 November 1980 Petitioner was discharged with an honorable character of service from the U.S. Navy Reserve.

d. On 26 July 2022 the State of [REDACTED] Certification of Vital Record issued  
Petitioner a certificate of live birth listing birthdate of [REDACTED].

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an error warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that in accordance with Petitioner's certification of Vital Record issued on 26 July 2022, Petitioner's date of birth is [REDACTED], not [REDACTED] as listed on his DD Form 4 and DD Form 214N.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 4 executed on 12 November 1974 listed block 21 (Date of birth)  
"[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED] [REDACTED]."

Petitioner's DD Form 214N executed on 11 November 1977 listed block 4 (Date of birth)  
"[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED] [REDACTED]."

Note: That any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
