Dear █,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

Although your application was not filed in a timely manner, the Board found it in the interest of justice to waive the statute of limitations and consider your case on its merits. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 26 January 2023. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

You requested your deployment overseas while assigned to █, █ (February 1982 through September 1985) be reflected on your DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty ending on 12 September 1985. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that in accordance with Marine Corps Order Publication 1900.16C, deployment data is not an appropriate remark for block 18 of the DD Form 214. However, your DD Form 214 does reflect you completed Foreign Service in block 12f for the temporary additional duty period of 4 August 1983 to 1 February 1984 (5 months and 28 days) with █, as indicated in your Service Record Book, Chronological Record.
