1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 15 March 2022 vice 18 March 2022 and was eligible for and received the Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) award level of 6.5 vice 5.0.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 1 June 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 12 March 2019, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 11 March 2023 and Soft EAOS of 11 March 2025.

b. In December 2020, Petitioner was awarded Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) N230.

c. On 16 November 2021, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3510) while stationed at [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of December 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 28 January 2022, with a Projected Rotation Date of January 2026. On 1 December 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 5 January 2022 for duty.

d. On 18 March 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 17 March 2028 and received a Zone A SRB.

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e. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner reenlisted on 18 March 2022 for 6 years and received a Zone A, ETN/N230, 5.0 award level SRB as approved using reference (d).<sup>1</sup> On 14 February 2022, reference (d) was released and reduced the award level for ETN/N230, Zone A from 6.5 to 5.0 effective 16 March 2022. For Petitioner to retain the higher award level, he had to reenlist prior to or on 15 March 2022. If the Command Career Counselor had requested from BUPERS-328 to change the reenlistment date from 18 March 2022 to 15 March 2022, it would have been approved.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's was discharged and reenlisted on "14/15 March 2022" vice "17/18 March 2022" for a term of 6 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a Zone "A" SRB with an award level of "6.5" vice "5.0" (\$100,000 dollar award ceiling) for the ETN/N230 rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 11 March 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's records to determine if Petitioner is due any back pay.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
