- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that the Agreement to Extend Enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 5 October 2020 was cancelled and his Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) is 26 June 2023 vice 26 December 2023.
- 2. The Board, consisting of property and previewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 22 December 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. On 27 June 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 26 June 2023.
- c. In accordance with reference (b), All recruiters and military support personnel will be screened for recruiting duty. The CO will certify that the member has been screened using NAVPERS 1306/93 Recruiting Duty Screening, (complete sections A, B, C, and D) which may be accessed by using the following Web address:

k. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was in receipt of BUPERS order: 2730, which required Petitioner to obligate service out to December 2023. Petitioner executed an agreement to extend enlistment for 6 months to meet the OBLISERV. Petitioner holds NECs N25S and 803R, which would qualify Petitioner for the exception to the 36-month OBLISERV

in accordance with reference (b). Furthermore, BUPERS order: 2730 was cancelled effective 2 December 2021, including the obligated service requirement and the need for the 6-month extension executed to meet it.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The 6-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 5 October 2020, is null and void. Note: This reestablishes the previous EAOS/SEAOS of 26 June 2023.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 5.
