1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to backdate commissioning date to the date of graduation from Officer Candidate School (OCS).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 31 January 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, she exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 23 July 2021 Petitioner signed NAVCRUIT 1131/104, Navy Flight Officer (1370) Service Agreement.

b. On 2 August 2021 Petitioner enlisted in the Navy for a term of 8 years, in which 4 years was an active duty obligation.

c. On 28 November 2021 Petitioner graduated OCS.

d. On 4 January 2022 Petitioner's first flight physical was adjudicated and waiver recommended by [REDACTED].

e. On 6 January 2022 Petitioner signed NAVPERS 1000/4, Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office and commissioned as an Ensign on active duty.

f. Petitioner was assigned to [REDACTED] for duty under instruction (DUIN) from 19 January 2022 through 5 October 2022.

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- g. On 30 March 2022 Petitioner's second flight physical was adjudicated and waiver recommended by [REDACTED]
- h. On 5 October 2022 Petitioner reported to [REDACTED] for DUIN.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner was medically cleared on 4 January 2022, thereby rendering her ineligible to be commissioned upon graduation from OSC on 28 November 2021 in accordance with reference (b).¹ Therefore, the Board felt, under this circumstance, partial relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

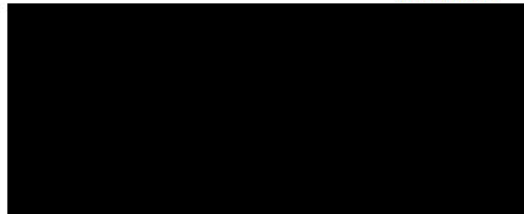
Petitioner signed NAVPERS 1000/4, Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office on "4 January 2022" vice "6 January 2022."

The part of Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing is denied in accordance with reference (b).

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
