1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 20 November 2022 and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 22 December 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 21 November 2016 Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 20 November 2020 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service of 20 November 2022.

b. On 11 September 2020 Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED], and arrived to [REDACTED] on 16 December 2020.

c. In accordance with reference (c), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13 SRB 001/FY23) a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the IS rate was listed.

d. On 2 November 2022 Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 6 year reenlistment effective 20 November 2022. Petitioner's request was approved on 9 November 2022 by cognizant authority.

e. On 21 November 2022 Petitioner's 14-month extension posted in Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System/Electronic Service Record became operative with an EAOS of 20 January 2024.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2),<sup>1</sup> the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 2 November 2022 Petitioner requested to reenlist for 6 years on 20 November 2022, at his EAOS. Petitioner had an inoperative 14-month extension that the Personnel Support Detachment (PSD) made operative. This resulted in his EAOS becoming 20 January 2024 and made Petitioner ineligible to reenlist for SRB in accordance with reference (b).<sup>2</sup>

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged on 19 November 2022 and reenlisted on 20 November 2022 for a term of 6 years. Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the IS rate.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.

<sup>2</sup> Reference (b), announced revised SRB policy for Active Component and Full-Time Support, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365-days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270-days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.
