1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show block 12a (Date entered AD this period) lists 21 January 2015 vice 21 January 2016 on Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active duty (DD Form 214) executed on 20 January 2020.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 February 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 21 January 2015 Petitioner arrived to [REDACTED] for temporary duty.

c. On 22 June 2015 Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0555) while stationed in [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of May 2015. Petitioner's intermediate (1) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 9 May 2015. Petitioner's intermediate (2) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 24 May 2015. Petitioner's intermediate (3) activity was [REDACTED] for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 May 2015. Petitioner's intermediate (4) activity was [REDACTED]

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[REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 6 June 2015. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 27 July 2015, with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of January 2020.

d. Petitioner was released from active duty and transferred the Naval Reserve with an Honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of 21 January 2016 to 20 January 2020 upon completion of required active service. Furthermore, Petitioner's reserve obligation termination date was 2 September 2022.

e. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was on Active Duty from 21 January 2015 until his release from active duty; however, Petitioner's DD Form 214 erroneously lists 21 January 2016 in block 12a (Date Entered AD This Period).

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214 executed on 20 January 2020 listed block 12a (Date entered AD this period) "21 January 2015" vice "21 January 2016". Note: That any other entries affected by the Board's recommendation be corrected.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
