1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting his record be corrected to change the social security number listed on his discharge documents. Enclosure (2) applies.

2. The Board, consisting of **Construction**, **Construction**, and **Construction**, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 February 2023, and, pursuant to its regulations, determined the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of his naval service records, and applicable statutes, regulations, policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Although enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to review the application on its merits.

c. Petitioner enlisted in the Marine Corps and entered active duty on 24 February 1966. Petitioner's application for enlistments reflects the social security number (SSN) **Example**. Petitioner was discharged with an Honorable character of service on 18 December 1968. Petitioner was issued a Report of Separation from Active Duty (DD Form 214) at the completion of his required active service, Block 3, of Petitioner's DD Form 214 erroneously reflects the SSN

d. Petitioner requests his discharge documents corrected to reflect his SSN. Petitioner provided a copy of his Individual Tax return, which reflects a SSN of the second s

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants favorable action. In this regard, the Board noted Petitioner DD Form 214 contains an administrative error. The Board determined Petitioner's DD Form 214 should reflect the number used upon his enlistment and during his service in the Marine Corps,

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action:

Petitioner be issued a Correction to DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 215), to indicate his SSN as a second second

No further changes be made to Petitioner's record.

A copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
