1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to include active duty period of service from 2 October 2016 through 30 September 2017 on Certificate or Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) ending on 30 September 2018.

2. The Board, consisting of **Constant 1**, **Constant 1**, and **Constant 1** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 February 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 2 September 2016 Petitioner issued BUPERS Orders (Official Active Duty Special Works (ADSW) orders) for a period of duty from 2 October 2016 through 30 September 2017 and ultimate activity,

b. On 1 October 2016 Petitioner reported to

c. On 24 August 2017 Petitioner issued BUPERS Orders (Official ADSW orders) for a period of duty from 1 October 2017 through 30 September 2018 and ultimate activity,

d. On 30 September 2018 Petitioner released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve. Petitioner issued a DD Form 214 for period of active duty service from 1 October 2017 to 30 September 2018.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded, Petitioner executed back-to-back ADSW orders at the same activity and his DD Form 214 dated 30 September 2018 should have included active duty service period of 2 October 2016 through 30 September 2017 in accordance with reference (b).<sup>1</sup> Therefore, the Board felt, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION


That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214 ending on 30 September 2018 is amended to reflect: Block 12.a. (Date Entered AD This Period) 2016 10 02 vice 2017 10 01 and Block 12.c. (Net Active Service This Period) 01 11 29 vice 01 00 00. Note: DD Form 215 shall be issued to correct error.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
