1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's authorization for a Standard Score Comparison of September 2020 (Cycle 248) for March 2020 (Cycle 247) and advancement determination of March 2021 (Cycle 251) based on additional Passed Not Advanced (PNA) point adjustments per references (b) and (c).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 January 2023 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. Petitioner contends she did not participate in the March 2020 (Cycle 247) Navy-wide advancement examination due to deployment and circumstances beyond her control.

b. During September 2020 Petitioner participates in the September 2020 (Cycle 248) with no PNA points applied from Cycle 244. Final Multiple Score is 134.30. Final Status PNA points earned 1.5 Standard Score and 1.5 Performance Mark Average.

c. During March 2021 Petitioner participates in the March 2021 (Cycle 251) with 3 PNA points applied from Cycle 248. Final Multiple Score is 140.98. Final Status PNA-PTS 1.5/1.5.

d. On 2 August 2021 CNO N132 approves exception to policy request from Cycle 248 and Cycle 247. Letter required to be forwarded to Career Progression Division (PERS-80) and NETPDC as necessary for validation. Note: No evidence of action taken.

e. On 16 May 2022 Petitioner advanced to AE1 E6 with a time in rate of 1 January 2022 after her selection for advancement from the September 2021 (Cycle 252) NWAE.

f. On NETPDC representative manually computes March 2020 (Cycle 247) standard score comparison with Cycle 248. FMS 122.83 / MMR 135.42; Final Status PNA-PTS 1.5 Standard Score earned. September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE recalculated 1.5 PNA points applied from Cycle 247; FMS now 135.80 vice 134.30. Final Status remains PNA-PTS 1.5/1.5. March 2021 (Cycle 251) NWAE recalculated with 4.5 PNA applied vice 3.0 from Cycles 247 and 248. FMS now 142.48 vice 140.98. Final Status Selected vice PNA-PTS 1.5/1.5, if approved by BCNR. Petitioner eligible advancement 16 December 2021 with TIR date of 1 July 2021.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded the Service did not corrective action on approval of Exception to Policy for Standard Score comparison of Cycle 248 to missed Cycle 247, warranting relief.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Standard Score Comparison between Cycle 248 and Cycle 247 executed.

Petitioner FMS for the March 2020 (Cycle 247) NWAE is 122.83; Final Status PNA-PTS 1.5.

Petitioner FMS for September 2020 (Cycle 248) NWAE is 135.80 vice 134.30; Final Status PNA-PTS 1.5/1.5.

Petitioner FMS for March 2021 (Cycle 251) NWAE is 142.48 vice 140.98; Final Status Selected vice PNA-PTS 1.5/1.5

Petitioner's advancement to AE1 E6 effective 16 May 2022 is rescinded.

Petitioner advanced to AE1 E6 effective 16 December 2021 with TIR of 1 July 2021.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
