



enclosure (1) paragraph 1202.4, a DD Form 214 will not be issued for personnel being removed from the temporary disability retired list. Consequently, your DD-214 issued 30 April 2001 is correct and the Board determined you are not entitled to another reflecting your transfer to the PDRL. The Board concluded the letter you received on 28 December 2005 sufficiently serves as documentation of your status on the PDRL. Accordingly, given the totality of the circumstances, the Board determined that your request does not merit relief.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
