e. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner was eligible for SDAP entitlement while serving as Deep Sea Diving Independent Duty Corpsman onboard in accordance with references (b) and (c). However, Petitioner's request for SDAP was improperly routed, thereby not processed in a timely manner resulting in the delay of beginning his SDAP entitlement. Therefore, the Board felt, under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was entitled to SDAP while assigned as Deep Sea Diving Independent Duty Corpsman (NEC L28A), onboard during the period of 1 October 2021 through 9 January 2023, at SDAP level SD-6 at the rate of \$450.00 per month.

Note: Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine retroactive SDAP entitlement due.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
