- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to establish eligibility to transfer Post-9/11 GI Bill education benefits to eligible dependents.
- 2. The Board, consisting of ______, and _____ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 15 February 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, she exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. Petitioner entered active duty service on 12 May 2004, and later reenlisted on 2 April 2019 for a term of 5 years.
- b. Petitioner submitted transfer of education benefits (TEB) application on 22 May 2019. The Service rejected the application indicating, Petitioner "has not committed to the required additional service time." Petitioner later completed TEB Statement of Understanding (SOU) on 19 January 2023, and on 20 January 2023 submitted her second TEB application at which time the Service rejected the application indicating, Petitioner "has not committed to the required additional service time."

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner met the basic eligibility criteria to transfer Post-9/11 GI Bill education benefits but failed to complete the required SOU before initially applying to TEB as outlined in reference (d) and upon reapplying, only had 14 months remaining on contract. Although Petitioner did not complete the proper administrative requirements, the Board felt, had she received the appropriate counseling, she would have taken the steps required to garner approval; therefore, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner, in coordination with her command completed the required TEB SOU on 22 May 2019 and submitted it to Commander, Navy Personnel Command for inclusion in the Petitioner's Official Military Personnel File.

Petitioner elected to transfer unused education benefits to ______/6-months and _____/30-months through the MilConnect TEB portal on 22 May 2019.

Commander, Navy Personnel Command (PERS-311) reviewed Petitioner's TEB application and it was approved on 22 May 2019 with a 4-year service obligation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
