Dear █,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 6 April 2023. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board also considered the advisory opinion by Community Management Support Branch (BUPERS-328) dated 15 February 2023, which was previously provided to you. You were afforded an opportunity to submit a rebuttal, but did not do so.

The Board determined that your personal appearance, with or without counsel, would not materially add to their understanding of the issues involved. Therefore, the Board determined that a personal appearance was not necessary and considered your case based on the evidence of record.

You requested your current contract extension be backdate to 16 July 2022 to complete obligated service for orders to the █ and authorize back pay of E-4 pay from 16 July 2022 to October 2022. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that you were issued BUPERS Order: 1642 (Official Change Duty Orders) on 13 June 2023 to transfer from the █ to █ with an obligated service requirement to April 2025. On 16 June 2022, BUPERS-3 notified you of your designation/advancement to Petty Officer Third Class/E-4. In this letter, you were advised that you were eligible with commanding officer's (CO) endorsement for advancement to
