1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 March 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 19 March 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 18 March 2022 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) of 18 March 2023.

c. On 2 August 2022, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2142) with required obligated service to June 2026, while stationed in ██████████, ██████████, ██████████ with an effective date of departure of February 2023. Petitioner's intermediate (1) activity was ██████████, ██████████, ██████████ for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 25 February 2023. Petitioner's intermediate (2) activity was

[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for temporary duty with an effective date of arrival of 16 March 2023. Petitioner's intermediate (3) activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for temporary duty under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 11 April 2023. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 June 2023, with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of June 2026.

d. In accordance with reference (b), this NAVADMIN announced revised SRB policy for Active Component (AC) and FTS, superseding NAVADMIN 272/19. Sailors must now have reenlisted within 365-days of their EAOS (as opposed to 270-days required in NAVADMIN 272/19), except in the case of Nuclear-trained Sailors who could have reenlisted at any point in the reenlistment zone, per guidance in OPNAVINST 1160.8B.

e. On 8 August 2022, Petitioner's [REDACTED] Reenlistment Request was submitted requesting a 4 year reenlistment effective 10 November 2022, and a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5. Petitioner's request was approved on 26 September 2022 by cognizant authority.

f. In accordance with reference (c), FY23 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 001/FY23) a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the ABH rate was listed.

g. On 10 November 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an EAOS of 9 November 2026.

h. On 7 February 2023, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED].

i. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that on 8 August 2022, Petitioner's [REDACTED] Reenlistment Request was submitted requesting a 4-year reenlistment effective 10 November 2022, and a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5. Petitioner's request was approved on 26 September 2022 by cognizant authority. At the time of reenlistment, Petitioner was eligible for SRB. The Command Career Counselor failed to submit the SRB precertification request within 35 to 120 days in advance of his requested reenlistment date. If the SRB precertification had been submitted, it would have been approved.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's Command submitted a request for his SRB to BUPERS-328 via OPINS/NSIPS in a timely manner and it was approved by cognizant authority.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 0.5 (\$30,000 dollar award ceiling) for the ABH rate. Remaining obligated service to 18 March 2023 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
