1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was reimbursed for her Personally Procured Move (PPM).

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 March 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 23 August 2022, ██████████ notified ██████████, ██████████ that parent commands listed in the to line of this message are directed to initiate the retirement processing of Petitioner and route to appropriate ██████████ by final out processing completion date of 17 September 2022. Permanent Disability Retired List (PDRL) date 27 November 2022.

b. On 21 October 2022, ██████████ Moving and Storage issued Petitioner an ██████████ of ██████████ contract and order for service with a balance due of \$ ██████████. Furthermore, ██████████ revised written estimate and post contract services order form were issued.

c. On 7 November 2022, Petitioner was issued official retirement orders (BUPERS order: 3112) while stationed in ██████████ with an effective date of departure of November 2022. Petitioner's home of selection: deferred with an effective date of 28 November 2022.

d. Petitioner was retired with an honorable character of service and was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 12 September 2017 to 27 November 2022 due to disability—permanent.

e. On 24 January 2024, [REDACTED] notified Petitioner that since no weight tickets were obtained and the date on her moving contract are before her orders date, Petitioner will need to appeal this through BCNR to see if NAVSUP can pay this as a reimbursement only.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of reference (b) and enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that per reference (b), household goods (HHG) allowances are based on when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute HHG transportation before an order is issued. The Board concluded that on 23 August 2022 Petitioner's command was notified of Petitioner's placement on the PDRL effective 27 November 2022, therefore, Petitioner had reason to believe that her official retirement orders would be forthcoming.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's official retirement orders (BUPERS order: 3112) were issued on "20 October 2022" vice "7 November 2022."

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
