1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was reimbursed for her Personally Procured Move (PPM).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 March 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 26 August 2022, Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that she had been selected for the N10 ADOS position.

b. On 27 September 2022, Certified Automated Truck Scale receipt was issued at [REDACTED] with gross weight of 17,800 lbs., and at 16:39 Certified Automated Truck Scale receipt was issued at [REDACTED] with gross weight of 24,569 lbs.

c. On 12 October 2022, Petitioner was issued BUPERS orders (Official Active Duty for Operational Support Orders) under the authority of Title 10 U.S.C. section 12301 (D) and in accordance with OPNAVINST 1001.20 series, Assistant Secretary of Defense (Reserve Affairs) memorandum dated 16 June 2004, Joint Travel Regulations (JTR), and RTN SW-5168-7941/ADOS RTN MPN-23-22-5168-7941. Period of duty: 1 November 2022 to 30 September 2023. Depart place from which called (or ordered) to active duty (PLEAD) NET 1 November 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was CHNAVPERs SUPPORT [REDACTED] for duty.

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d. On 15 October 2022 [REDACTED] issued Petitioner an Interstate Bill of Lading Contract and Order for Service with a grand total of 9,750.80.

e. On 1 November 2022, Petitioner arrived to CHNPERSUP [REDACTED] for duty. Petitioner's basic pay and entitlements started.

f. On 12 January 2023, Petitioner signed Application for Personally Procured Move and Counseling Checklist (DD Form 2278) listing a PPM move authorized from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] with a maximum authorized weight of 13,000 lbs. and Estimated Constructive Costs of \$18,803.02. On 12 January 2023, Office Performing Closeout (JBMHH) sign the form.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of reference (b) and enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded per reference (b) household goods (HHG) allowances are based on the when orders are effective and certain criteria must be met in order to execute HHG transportation before an order is issued. On 26 August 2022, Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that she had been selected for the N10 ADOS position; therefore, Petitioner had reason to believe that Official Active Duty for Operational Support Orders would be forthcoming.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's BUPERS orders (Official Active Duty for Operational Support Orders) were issued on 26 September 2022 vice 12 October 2022.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
