1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's reenlistment of 6 January 2022 was executed for a term of 3 years vice 5 years.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 April 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. On 30 May 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 29 May 2022.

b. On 14 December 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 3431) with required obligated service to February 2025, while stationed at [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of January 2022. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 February 2022, with a Projected Rotation Date (PRD) of February 2025.

c. On 22 December 2021, Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 3 year reenlistment effective 6 January 2022. Petitioner's request was approved on 5 January 2022 by cognizant authority.

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d. On 6 January 2022, Petitioner reenlisted for 5 years with an EAOS of 5 January 2027.

e. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was in receipt of orders requiring service out to February 2025. Petitioner signed a command career request (NPPSC 1160/1) requesting a 3 year reenlistment effective 6 January 2022. Due to administrative oversight, Petitioner's reenlistment contract listed a term of 5 years. The Board determined that Petitioner only needed to reenlist for 3 years and execute a 1-month extension of enlistment in order to meet the required OBLISERV to execute his Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 6 January 2022 is for a term of 3 years, vice 5 years.

Petitioner signed a 1-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 6 January 2025.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
