1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show his correct Social Security Number on his Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) executed on 23 February 1989 and to add foreign service.

2. The Board, consisting of █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 23 May 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. On 19 July 1984, Petitioner's Application for Enlistment Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 1966) and DD Form 4 listed Petitioner's social security number of 5162.

b. Petitioner's Career Sea Service Eligibility Affidavit listed the following: █ - Destination █ (15 June 1986 to 27 June 1986), and █ (17 August 1987 to 27 August 1987). Petitioner's Individual Deployment Record listed the following: █ (16 February 1986 to 26 February 1986), █ (2 April 1986 to 7 October 1986), and █ (17 August 1987 to 27 August 1987). Petitioner's Chronological record (NAVMC 118(3)) listed the following units he was attached to during his military career: █ Battalion, █ Marines, █ Marine Division, █ █ form 1986 to 1987 and █ Battalion, █ Marines, █ Marine Division, █ from 1987 to 1989.

c. Petitioner was discharged with an Honorable character of service and was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of 17 July 1985 to 23 February 1989 due to Physical Disability with Severance Pay. Furthermore, Block 3 (Social security no.) listed █, and block 12f (Foreign service) listed 00 00 00.

d. Petitioner's Form SSA 1099 Social Security Benefit Statement (2022) listed Box 2 (Beneficiary's social security number) █

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CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of reference (b)¹ and enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that according to Petitioner's DD Form 1966, DD Form 4, and SSA 1099 Social Security Benefit Statement, his last four of his SSN is [REDACTED] however, the SSN listed on Petitioner's DD Form 214 executed on 23 February 1989 is incorrect. Regarding Petitioner's foreign service, although the Board agreed that Petitioner deployed with his unit on a West Pac, there is no evidence that Petitioner was issued orders and stationed on foreign service.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214 executed on 23 February 1989 listed block 3 (Social security no.) [REDACTED] vice [REDACTED]. Note: Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps will issue a DD Form 215 or a new DD Form 214, whichever one they deem appropriate, that reflects this corrective action.

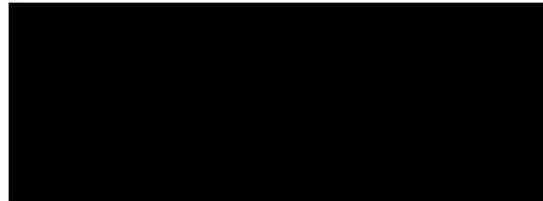
That part of the Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing be denied.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

¹ Reference (b), prepare and physically deliver a DD Form 214 to Marines upon: Release from Active Service. Except as provided in paragraph 1202.3, a DD Form 214 will be furnished to each Marine at the time of separation from a period of active duty. This includes separation from a period of actual or apparent (de jure or de facto) service as well as release from an enlistment that is void by minority. Social Security Number. Enter the SSN in the same sequence as Marine's social security card, less hyphens, in the blocks provided. For example: 888 88 8888. Foreign Service: Enter in years, months, and days, the time spent *on* foreign service during current active service period. Foreign duty areas are defined in DoDPM. If the Marine has no foreign service enter zeros: "00 00 00."
