1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect date entered active duty service as 6 April 1993 on his DD Form 214, Certificate of Discharge or Release from Active ending on 30 April 2013.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 April 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 13 August 1992, Petitioner enlisted into the United States Navy, and entered active duty on 6 April 1993.

b. On 4 November 1997, Petitioner discharged for immediate reenlistment and was not issued a DD Form 214 in accordance with reference (c), and reenlisted for a term of 3 years on 5 November 1997.

c. On 30 April 2013, Petitioner transferred to the Fleet Reserve and was issued a DD Form 214 for an active duty service period of 5 November 1997 to 30 April 2013 and accounted for prior active service of 4 years, 6 months, and 27 days.

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CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner's was not issued a DD Form 214 for his active duty service from 6 April 1993 through 4 November 1997. In accordance with reference (c),¹ the date entered active duty this period on the DD Form 214 ending on 30 April 2013 should reflect 6 April 1993 vice capturing the aforementioned period as prior active service. Therefore, the Board felt, under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 214, Certificate of Discharge or Release from Active Duty ending on 30 April 2013 is amended to reflect Block 12a (Date Entered AD this Period) "93 APR 06" vice "97 NOV 05"; Block 12c (Net Active Service this Period) "20 00 25" vice "15 05 26"; and Block 12d (Total Prior Active Service) "00 00 00" vice "04 06 27."

Note: Navy Personnel Command will issue a DD Form 215 or a new DD Form 214 whichever one they deem appropriate.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.

¹ Reference (b), the DD Form 214 will be prepared and furnished to members while serving on active duty when they have a change of status or component such as enlisted personnel discharged for the purpose of immediate enlistment or reenlistment. Reference (c), ended the authorization to issue a DD Form 214 to members discharged for the purpose of immediate reenlistment in the Navy on 28 June 1993.
