Dear █,

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 15 June 2023. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

You requested correction to your DD 214N, Report of Separation from Active Duty ending on 9 December 1976 to reflect date entered active duty as 29 October 1973 and total active service of 3 years, 1 month, and 4 days. The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. Upon review of your official military personnel file, the Board concluded that you enlisted on 29 October 1974 and reported to Recruit Training Command (RTC), █ the same day. You departed RTC, █ on 4 February 1975 and report to █ on 9 February 1975, you were station onboard █ from 24 February 1975 to 1 December 1976. Thereafter, you reported to █ on 1 December 1976 to your date of discharge on 9 December 1976. The Board could not find, nor did you provide evidence of service prior to 29 October 1974, therefore, a change to your record is not warranted.
