1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to reflect Home of Record (HOR) as ██████████ vice ██████████

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 6 April 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. In accordance with reference (b), Marines may not change their HOR upon appointment/reappointment to commissioned grade or reenlistment. Such changes are only authorized when there is a break in service of more than one full day or if the HOR on the enlistment/reenlistment document, record of induction or appointment acceptance and record, is determined to be erroneous.

b. On 26 November 1996, Petitioner enlisted in the Marine Corps Reserve for a term of 8-years of which 4 years was an active duty obligation. Petitioner's DD Form 4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Documents reflects HOR as ██████████, ██████████, ██████████." However, Petitioner's DD Form 1666, Record of Military Processing indicates HOR as ██████████, ██████████, ██████████ USA ██████████." DD Form 1666 also reflects Petitioner born in ██████████, ██████████ had a valid ██████████ driver's license. Active Duty Service Date: 21 July 1997.

c. In May 1997, Petitioner graduated from ██████████ High School in ██████████, ██████████

d. On 21 July 1997, Petitioner entered active duty from Military Entrance Processing Center, ██████████, ██████████

e. On 20 September 2001, Petitioner discharged and issued DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty with Block 7b (Home of Record at Time of Entry) indicating, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

f. On 21 September 2001, Petitioner assigned to the Individual Ready Reserve to complete his military service obligation.

g. On 3 January 2002, Petitioner honorably discharged from the Marine Corps Reserve and enlisted in the Army National Guard on 4 January 2002.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner's DD Form 1966 reflects current address in Oklahoma and HOR in New Mexico. The Board concluded a mistake was made by annotating the Oklahoma address in Block 3 (HOR) of DD Form 4. Therefore, the Board felt, under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 4, Enlistment/Reenlistment Document dated 26 November 1996 is amended to reflect Block 3 (Home of Record) "[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED], [REDACTED]."

Petitioner's DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty ending on 20 September 2001 is modified to reflect Block 7.b. (Home of Record at Time of Entry) "[REDACTED], [REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED].". Note: Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps will issue a DD Form 215 or a new DD Form 214 whichever one they deem appropriate.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
