CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was in receipt BUPERS order: 2902) which required obligated service to January 2026. A 4-year term reenlistment would satisfy this required obligated service.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 20 January 2023 was for a term of 4 years vice 6 years. Note: This will establish an EAOS of 19 January 2027.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
