This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 19 December 2023. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion by Navy Personnel Command memorandum 1900 PERS-312/SA of 3 August 2023, which was previously provided to you. You were afforded an opportunity to submit a rebuttal, but did not do so.

You requested your DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty reflect your assignment onboard the ██████████). The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that in accordance with Navy Military Personnel Instruction 1900.1B, the DD Form 214 will be prepared for personnel being separated from a period of active duty for training (ADT), only when service was of 90 days or more.

A review of your record indicates you completed ADT at Recruit Training Command, Naval Training Center, ██████████, ██████████ from 18 January 1985 to 30 April 1985 and issued a DD Form 214 for that period of service. Your next period of ADT service eligible for a DD Form 214 was completed on the ██████████) from 12 July 1987 to 10 March 1989. Thereafter, you were assigned to the ██████████) in a Reserve drill pay status from 10 April 1989 to 15 August 1991. During your assignment to the ██████████), you executed ADT orders from 5 August 1990 to 17 August 1990. The Board agreed that your Reserve assignment and ADT orders onboard the ██████████) did not meet the
