1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to void reenlistment contract dated 10 June 2023.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 28 September 2023 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. In accordance with reference (b), Selected Reserve are eligible for a Selected Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) provided the member's rating is listed, the member reenlists within the same fiscal year (FY) as their expiration of obligated service (EOS) and they reenlist for a term of three or six years. Reference (c) specifies the Aviation Boatswain's Mate rating is an eligible rating for a Tier 3, Zone A/B SRB.

b. Petitioner served on active duty from 26 March 2013 to 15 January 2022.

c. On 16 January 2022, Petitioner enlisted in the Navy Reserve for 2 years; EOS 15 January 2024.

d. On 10 June 2023, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years and reenlistment contract indicated, "Per FY23 SRB Reserve Incentive MSG 4 Oct 22, Reenlist ABH/NEC: 0000, Term: 6-Year, Tier: 3, Amount: \$10,000." Additionally, "Reenlistment Bonus Required Page 13" NAVPERS 1070/613, Administrative Remarks was uploaded to Petitioner's electronic service record indicating he was reenlisting for 6-years and entitled to an SRB.

e. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. In accordance with reference (b), the Board determined Petitioner did not meet the eligibility criteria for an FY2023 SRB because he reenlisted outside of his EOS FY. The Board concluded, Petitioner received inadequate counseling, therefore determined under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's NAVPERS 1070/601, Immediate Reenlistment Contract dated 10 June 2023 for 6 years is null and void. Note: This change reverts Petitioner EOS to 15 January 2024.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
