1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to reflect place from which called or ordered to active duty (PLEAD)<sup>1</sup> is ██████████ vice ██████████.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 January 2024 and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, she exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

- a. On 18 April 2016, Petitioner assigned to Navy Reserve Center (NRC) ██████████.
- b. On 8 November 2019, Petitioner's DD Form 93, Record of Emergency Data reflects spouse's address was ██████████ and dependent children's address was overseas.
- c. On 24 July 2020, Petitioner assigned to ██████████.
- d. On 27 October 2020, Petitioner issued BUPERS Mobilization Order: 3010 with address indicating ██████████ and Ready to Load Date (RLD) 23 April 2021.

<sup>1</sup> Reference (b), PLEAD is used for a member of the Reserve Component to determine entitlement to travel and transportation allowances or other compensations provided by law. The PLEAD for a reserve member ordered to active duty will be recorded on the member's orders to active duty and in the Electronic Service Record (ESR).

e. On 9 April 2021, Petitioner issued modification to BUPERS Mobilization Order: 3010 changing RLD to 4 June 2021.

f. On 4 June 2021, Petitioner's Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS) ESR home address was updated to [REDACTED].

g. On 9 June 2021, Petitioner executed BUPERS Mobilization Order: 3010.

h. In the advisory opinion, attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded sufficient evidence was provided to reflect Petitioner's permanent address is [REDACTED]. However, NSIPS ESR and DD Form 93, Record of Emergency Data reflected Petitioner's temporary address while working overseas in a civilian capacity. Although Petitioner did not complete the proper administrative requirements in a timely manner, the Board determined that under this circumstance, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's BUPERS Mobilization Order: 3010 (Official Recall to Active Duty Orders) issued on 27 October 2020 is amended to reflect address of "[REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED]."

That a copy of this report of proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
