This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 29 February 2024. The names and votes of the members of the panel will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of this Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application, together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies. In addition, the Board considered the advisory opinion contained in Officer of the Chief of Naval Operations 7220 SerN130/23U1231 of 18 October 2023, which was previously provided to you for comment.

You requested to establish entitlement to Continuation Pay (CP). The Board, in its review of your entire record and application, carefully weighed all potentially mitigating factors, to include your assertions. The Board concluded that you did not meet the eligibility criteria to receive CP in accordance with Military Personnel Manual Article 1810-081. Specifically, the policy indicates members must be enrolled in the Blended Retirement System (BRS) to be eligible for CP. Additionally, members who have passed 12 years of service are not eligible to receive CP. For the purpose of CP eligibility, 12 years of service is computed from the member's Pay Entry Base Date (PEBD).

A review of your record reflects you served on active duty from 12 September 2005 to 1 July 2009. Upon release from active duty, you transferred to the Individual Ready Reserve effective 2 July 2009 to complete your military service obligation. On 11 July 2011, you affiliated with a Selected Reserve unit until your discharge from the Navy Reserve on 9 February 2012. You joined the Air Force Air National Guard of the United States (AF-ANGUS), completed Active Duty for Training from 25 March 2012 to 26 June 2012, and thereafter on 3 January 2017, you
